

Mother Daughter FAQs

Q: Who can attend?

A: Bring mothers, daughters, grandmas, aunts, nieces, cousins, and any important females in your life for the weekend.

Q: What is included in the fee?

A: Lodging, meals, and programming are included.

Q: What do I need to bring?

A: You will need to bring bedding (pillow, & sleeping bag or sheets & blankets), toiletry articles (including bug spray & sunscreen), towels and seasonal clothing. Bring normal camp attire that can get dirty or wet. There will be a "Zany Campfire" on Saturday night. Feel free to bring fun "zany" clothes to dress up for this. Tie Dye is planned so you are encouraged to bring a couple white or light items like a T-shirt to tie dye!

Q: Where will my daughter and I stay?

A: Ladies will stay in buildings with three rooms (or cabins) with up to 12 total beds (6 bunk beds) in per room. There are shared bathrooms in the building.

Q: How are ladies divided into cabins?

A: You can request a cabin mate if you are coming with friends. Otherwise, women will be group with similarly aged children. If your family members have different last names, please request each other as cabin mates when registering so we can try to assign you to the same cabin.

Q: Can camp you accommodate special dietary restrictions and food allergies?

A: Yes, we can accommodate most of these provided we know ahead of time. Please list special dietary restrictions and food allergies including vegetarian or vegan when you register. Or reach out to camp at camp@crmetroymca.org to discuss needs so our chef can have appropriate food available.

Q: What activities are offered?

A: Several activities are open throughout the entire weekend and include but are not limited to basketball, tennis, gaga, tetherball, and sand volleyball. Additionally, some activities, which require camp staff leadership, are scheduled into time blocks and may include climbing, zip lining, tie-dye, arts & crafts, canoeing, and archery. Schedules will be available in the main lodge and at check in.

Q: What happens if it rains?

A: Some activities may be moved indoors or some alternative activities may be implemented. However, come prepared to get wet and have fun. Climbing can still happen in a drizzle.

Q: Where do I go when I arrive?

A: Check in is located in the gazebo by the parking lot. At check in, you will find out your cabin assignment and receive your Mother Daughter t-shirt. If you arrive after the check in time, please meet us in the lodge. If you know you will be arriving late or not able to stay the whole weekend please let camp know in advance so we can make appropriate plans.
